About This Software

The Genesys intelligent Workload Distribution Capture Adapter for IBM WebSphere MQ ("iWD Capture Adapter for WebSphere MQ") connects third-party task originating systems (such as business process management or workflow solutions) to Genesys intelligent Workload Distribution, via the IBM WebSphere MQ interface. The iWD Capture Adapter for WebSphere MQ provides a fully bidirectional link and supports the full set of iWD capabilities, such as task creation, updating, holding, and canceling, as well as various task state change notifications.

Optionally, the iWD Capture Adapter for WebSphere MQ supports message transformation. In this case, each incoming XML message as well as each outgoing message is passed through transformation scripts allowing integration with custom XML formats. These transformation scripts can also be customized.

Genesys intelligent Workload Distribution is a business application for dynamically prioritizing the distribution of work tasks to the people best suited to handle them. With Genesys iWD, enterprises can effectively manage all customer service resources and business processes across the enterprise, going beyond the walls of the formal contact center and into other areas of the business like branch offices, remote or home agents, and experts in the back-office.

Genesys iWD uses a global task list, sorted based on business value, to help enterprises ensure that the right resources, regardless of location, are proactively receiving the most critical or highest value tasks at the right time.
