

## **About This Software**

For Genesys 8.0, the Real-Time Metrics Engine CD contains Stat Server 8.0.

Stat Server tracks information about customer interaction networks (contact center, enterprise-wide, multi-enterprise telephony, and computer networks). Stat Server tracks voice and multimedia interactions, agent and person workload, group performance, and directory numbers (DN) usage and converts such data into a variety of statistics. This enables organizations to maximize the efficiency and flexibility of customer interaction networks.

### New Features in Release 8.0.x

The 8.0.0 release of the Real-Time Metrics Engine includes the following new features:

- Improved consistency between Stat Server metrics and Historical Reporting metrics provided by Genesys Interaction Concentrator and its downstream applications.
- Support for secure communications to and from Stat Server and other select Genesys applications.
- XML metadata for use with the Stat Server application template for lookup and validation of configuration options within Genesys Administrator.
- Enhanced stuck-call monitoring in virtual queues.
- Configurable setting of the initial average handling time for balancing interactions across queues.
- Storage of an interaction's ID in the STATUS table for multimedia interactions.
- The ability to filter switch-specific features recorded in the AttributeExtensions attribute of telephony events.
- The ability to use comparison operators within the filters defined for reason codes.
- Recognition of additional dialing modes and generation of additional actions to support Outbound campaigns that use IP infrastructure.
- Additional log message to warn when the number of pending SQL statements in memory has reached a preset threshold.
- Support of Agent statistics for SMS and Virtual Queue Handle time for Chat in a multimedia environment.
